

General Dress Requirements

At Foothill our goal is to teach students to dress appropriately and to encourage students to dress in a way that will reflect Biblical standards such as modesty. Because the subject of dress is usually a controversial one and because individuals have different opinions about what is considered appropriate, we ask that you consider the dress standard before enrolling your child in FBS.

Teachers need to focus their attention in areas other than monitoring dress. Therefore, we ask parents to take an active role in assisting students in following the dress code. This code is in effect when students are on campus, including before and after school. Uniforms are also required for field trips and other related school activities. Uniforms must be purchased through Normans Uniform. Students violating the dress code will not be allowed to enter school facilities in the morning. They will be sent home to change into the proper attire.

Parents that participate in or attend school events are asked to set the right example for students by wearing clothing that would be comparable (dresses or skirts below the knee for ladies and pants and collared shirts for men).

Elementary Boys Dress Code:

- Navy or Khaki pants from Norman's Uniforms
- White, light blue, navy, red, grey or yellow short or long sleeve polo shirts from Norman's Uniforms
- Black, navy, or khaki leather belt
- Solid white or navy socks
- Tennis shoes or dress shoes
- Shirts must remain tucked in at all times
- Undershirts, if worn, must be solid white
- Navy polar fleece jacket or cardigan sweater from Norman's Uniforms

Secondary Boys Dress Code:

- Navy, khaki or black pants from Norman's Uniforms
- Light blue, navy, red, grey or yellow short or long sleeve polo shirts from Norman's Uniforms
- Black leather belt/navy or khaki belt
- Solid white, black or navy socks
- Casual dress shoe in black or brown (no boots or tennis shoes)
- Shirts must remain tucked in at all times
- Undershirts, if worn, must be solid white
- Navy polar fleece jacket or cardigan sweater from Norman's Uniforms

No chains or straps may be worn in connection with clothing or hanging out of pockets. Pants must be pulled up at all times.

Haircuts are required on a regular basis. Boys' hair must be kept clean and combed out of the eyes. Hair must be off the ears, above the collar and tapered. Traditional boy's cut; military cut and flat tops are permitted. No bi-level, stepped, spiked, or shaved haircuts. Boys are not to alter the color of their hair. Any style considered to be extreme by the administration will not be permitted.

Facial hair must be clean shaven at all times. Sideburns can be no longer than half way down the ear.

Boys may wear watches. No other jewelry is permitted. Body piercing, tattoos and make-up are not permitted. Hats, caps and beanies are not to be worn in the buildings.

Only hats, caps, jackets or outerwear with FBS logos, approved Christian college logos and approved name brand logos are permitted.

Elementary Girl's Dress Code:

- Navy skirt or blue plaid jumper (below the knee) from Norman's Uniforms
- White Middy or Peter Pan blouse from Norman's Uniforms
- White, light blue, navy, red, grey or yellow long or short sleeve polo shirts from Norman's Uniforms
- Navy bike shorts
- Solid red, white or navy socks or tights

- Shirts must remained tucked in at all times
- Tennis shoes or dress shoes
- Navy polar fleece or nylon hooded jacket or cardigan sweater

Extreme hairstyles are to be avoided. Make-up and hair color are not permitted. Jewelry is to be moderate and conservative. Only one pair of earrings is to be worn at a time, one ring per hand, one necklace and one bracelet. Anklets are not permitted. Body piercing and tattoos are not permitted. Any style considered to be extreme by the administration will not be permitted.

Secondary Girl's Dress Code:

- Navy or khaki skirt (below the knee) from Norman's Uniforms
- White fitted blouse
- Light blue, navy, red, grey or yellow long or short sleeve polo shirts from Norman's Uniforms
- Solid white/navy socks, nylons, tights or peds must be worn
- Dress or casual shoes in black or brown (no boots or tennis shoes)
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times
- Navy polar fleece or nylon hooded jacket or cardigan sweater

Extreme hairstyles must be avoided and hair color cannot be altered. Make-up, if worn should be moderate and neutral in color. Use of nail polish is also to be worn with discretion (no black or neon colors).

Jewelry is to be moderate and conservative in appearance. Only one pair of earrings is to be worn at a time, one ring per hand, one necklace and one bracelet. Anklets are not permitted. Body piercing and tattoos are not permitted. Any style considered to be extreme by the administration will not be permitted.

Only hats, jackets or outerwear with FBS logos, approved Christian college logos and approved name brand logos are permitted.
